Autoclave Method – Up to 1/4" thickness: 1 hour @ 260°F/127°C (20 psi). 1/4" to 3/8" thick: 3 hours @ 260°F (20 psi)

Internal Steam Method – Up to 1/4" thickness: 4 hours @ 260°F/127°C (20 psi) or 7 hours at 240°F/116°C (10 psi).

Atmospheric Steam Method – Up to 1/4" Minimum 24 hours at 212°F
